#### **Competition Requirements**

- This show will be conducted and judged in accordance with the <u>United States Rules for Working Equitation</u>, Revision 6, dated 1 January 2023. The rules can be found at the following site: <u>https://usawe.org/rules</u>. It is the competitor's responsibility to read and understand the rules prior to the competition.
- All competitors holding a membership with USAWE may compete. Non-members are allowed to compete in licensed shows for a \$20 non-member fee. Non-members can use a one-time voucher in place of the non-member fee.

Competitors interested in being eligible for lifetime medal awards and year-end awards must be USAWE members.

All competing horses must be recorded with USAWE in advance of the show. A one-time fee of \$20 per horse includes lifetime performance tracking.

- A single horse and rider team is allowed to show in only one level. A horse may be entered twice in a competition if ridden by two different riders and in different levels. Exception: Two youth or one youth and one adult can share the same horse if competing in Level 1. See Rulebook, Section 1.8.
- Riders must be correctly attired and horses properly presented in accordance with the <u>U.S. Rules for Working</u> <u>Equitation</u>. Show Management may, at its discretion, bar any person or horse from entering the arena if not suitably presented.

#### Entries:

- Open to all breeds through USAWE Level 5.
- One entry form per horse and rider combination.
- All entries need entry form, Coggins, liability release and fees.
- An entry form is not valid unless it is fully completed and has all the proper signatures, membership numbers, and horse information. Each entry form must have the original (not copies) signatures of Riders/Handlers and the Owner/Agent. An adult must sign for any junior rider.
- Proof of a negative Coggins test, dated within one year of the end of the show, must accompany the entry form. Entries without a current (valid through show date) Coggins test result will not be accepted.
- Entries must be emailed to Aimee Edwards at aedwards@mclennan.edu.
- Closing date March 17, Limited rides time available.
- Entries received after **March 17**, based on availability, may be accepted with a late fee of **\$25**. *Full refund, minus office fee, on or before entry closing date. No refunds after closing date. No refunds without a written explanation from a veterinarian or doctor. No refunds unless we can fill your spot.*

### **Awards**

- Ribbons for all phases through fifth place. Level ribbons for all category of riders through fifth place.
- Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons for each level. Champion and Reserve highpoint in each level.

### The Show

- Ride times will be emailed to each entrant, posted at the show office and pasted on our Facebook page.
- Classes may NOT run in order.
- **Course maps** for EOH and Speed will be posted no earlier than 48 hours prior to the start of the show and no later than 2 hours prior to the start of each trial.

#### **Stabling Details**

- Stabling All horses must have a stall at \$25 a night. <u>No tying to the trailer</u>. Stalls are permanent 10x10 wood/metal construction with doors and dirt floor. Two bags of shavings are provided with each stall. Additional bags may be purchased for \$8 per bag
- Manure disposal is located behind the facility in three-sided concrete forms.
- Arrival/Schooling: Arrival beginning 9:00 AM on Thursday. Indoor arena closes at 8:00 pm every night. Schooling is available in the main arena and will be closed 30 min before classes start on Saturday.
- Early arrivals and late departures are only available by arrangement and the cost is \$30 a day plus \$25/night/stall. Cost applies to horse stalls or tack stalls. Stalls must be vacated by 9 p.m. Sunday or the late departure fee of \$25 paid.
- Check in Stall charts will be located at the show office and check-in will start at 5PM on Friday.
- Noncompeting Horses are welcome. Owner must fill out an entry form with all release signatures, send a current Coggins a stall fee.
